

Consultation on changes to bus services 104, 105, 106 & 275

We received a number of responses to this consultation and would like to thank those who took the time to respond. The responses were largely supportive of the proposed timetables and in particular of the routing of service 275 via Bledlow Ridge during the day.

The new 275 timetable is attached and will operate from **Tuesday 3 January 2012** when services 104 / 105 / 106 will be withdrawn.

We have also recently received notice that Tiger Line are withdrawing their commercial T3 bus route between High Wycombe and Princes Risborough and we will be subsidising a replacement service which will be operated by Redline Buses, starting on **Wednesday 28 December 2011**. A new timetable is attached.

We received a number of requests to retain evening peak journeys to Bradenham and Saunderton and have been able to include these in the new 321 timetable although usage will need to increase for them to be retained in the long term. We will be doing some additional promotion of these journeys to encourage more passengers but will need to keep them under review.

Summary of changes:

Bledlow Ridge and Chorley Road

Served by the new 275 service operated by Red Rose Travel with journeys to High Wycombe and Oxford from 3 January 2012.

Bradenham & Saunderton

Served by the new 321 service operated by Red Line Buses from 28th December 2011.

Longwick & Bledlow Village

Will continue to be served by Arriva 120, Redline 320 or Risborough Community Bus journeys. Service 105 / 6 withdrawn from 3 January 2012.

Ibstone & Radnage

No longer served by scheduled bus route from 3 January 2012.
