What are we doing?

In September we will be closing Risborough Road overnight for approximately 16 nights to allow us to install the Risborough Road temporary bridge.

The bridge will be a prefabricated structure that will need to be lifted into position over the road. To ensure the safety of road users and our workforce we will be closing road overnight to complete the installation.

It is intended to carry our site traffic over Risborough Road, allowing us to demobilise the plant crossing we currently have on the road thereby reducing our impact on the local traffic.

When will these works take place?

Friday 8 to Sunday 24 September; these works are overnight only (between 8:30pm - 5:30am).

These dates are subject to change due to circumstances beyond our control. Should the works be completed earlier than schedules the road closures will be removed.

Works will take place between Friday 8 to Sunday 24 September.

The closure and overnight works take place between 8:30pm and 5:30am.

Construction works taking place through the night.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.




